Tatiana Rosito is a Brazilian economist and senior diplomat, currently working as a consultant to the New Development Bank in Shanghai. She is also a Senior Fellow at the Brazilian Center for International Relations (CEBRI) --where she created and coordinated the China Analysis Group-- and a member of the Consultative Committee of the China-Brazil Business Council (CBBC). Tatiana has worked over ten years in Asia, where she served at the Brazilian Embassies in Beijing and Singapore, after serving at the Brazilian Mission to the United Nations in New York. She was Petrobras' Chief-Representative in China and General Manager for Business Development in Asia from 2017 to 2019. Previously, she was Executive Secretary at the Brazilian Foreign Trade Board (CAMEX), Special Advisor to the Ministers of Finance and Planning and advisor at the Brazilian Presidency. She holds a Master's degree in International Development from the Harvard Kennedy School and an Executive MBA from INSEAD and Tsinghua University. Her latest work "Foundations for Brazil's Long-Term Strategy Toward China" was published by CBBC and translated into English and Chinese.
